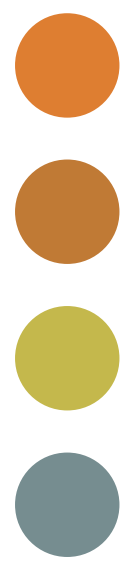

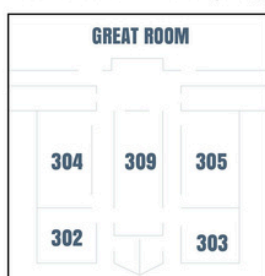

CAMPUS MAPS

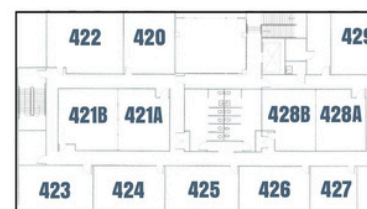
FAMILY LIFE CENTER (FLC)
